



FREE Developmental Screening

A **FREE** developmental screening is available to all children ages 2½-5 years old. This screening is intended for children that are not already enrolled in school and are not planning to attend Salem's 4K program during the 2019-2020 school year. Students are required to live within Paris or Salem school districts.

What is developmental screening and why is it important?

Developmental screening is a combination of activities and play that focus on speech, motor and readiness skills such as colors, shapes and counting.

Developmental screening is important because it assesses your child's learning and indicates if your child has prerequisite skills necessary for school.
