III. COMMUNITY OUTREACH

1. RedPages (message from Holly Dammann) – Panther RedPages were distributed in September. Overall, everything went well for this year's RedPages.

2. CHS Homecoming / Panther Pride Float (message from Beth LaBell) – Central's Homecoming Parade will take place on Wednesday, October 1, 2019. The float will match to this year's theme of "*Music: We Will, We Will, Rock You.*" Sunglasses for students riding on the float and candy to throw will be provided. Two hundred (\$200.00) dollars was spent on banners for the float.

3. Share Basket (Jodi Matthews) – Share Basket kick-off takes place during the Halloween Party which will be held on Wednesday, October 23, 2019. Jodi needs names of volunteers from Marie to help with Share Basket this year, including those who will be able to help "man" the Share Basket table at the Halloween Party. Jodi shared with one new family in attendance what Share Basket is all about. The Lenfestey Family/UNFI has donated the turkeys the past three years.

The funding request for this event will occur next month. PSO typically donates one hundred (\$100.00) dollars per family. Jackie Gerou knows of an anonymous donor who would like to contribute money towards that amount.

IV. SOCIAL AND ENTERTAINMENT

1. Halloween Party (Nikki and Ryan Niccolai) – The Halloween Party has been set for Wednesday, October 23, 2019. A theme has not been mentioned. The DJ needs to be contacted and booked yet; In the past, Spoon Bailey was the party's DJ and charged two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars and that comes from the donation from the Town of Paris. Nikki is in contact with the Town and is waiting on a check approval. Three hundred (\$300.00) dollars was approved by PSO in September.

V. TEACHER AND STAFF SUPPORT

1. Teacher Wish Lists – PSO approved the two thousand seven hundred (\$2,700.00) dollars for Teacher Wish Lists in September.

VI. FUNDRAISING

1. Panther Prowl (message from Beth LaBell) –

Jackie mentioned that all food sold at the Concessions Stand will now be prepared in the Paris School kitchen. Baked goods will continue to be made and donated by school and community volunteers.
- The bake sale sign-up sheet went home with students last week.
- Students are encouraged to wear Spirit Wear on Tuesday, October 8th.

VII. OTHER BUSINESS

1. POPS (Nikki Niccolai) – The first Paws Store of the school year will be held on Wednesday, October 9th and will continue to be held the second Wednesday of each month thereafter.
