



## PSO Meeting Minutes September 9, 2025

Called to Order: 6:33 PM

- **Secretary's Report:** May meeting minutes reviewed. No changes were needed. Meeting minutes approved by Tritt and Kordecki. Executive minutes also provided and reviewed, no changes were needed.
- **Treasurer's Report:** Since the last meeting, school expenses were paid out to Kristina in July. The balance looks good to date.
  
- **Paris Red Pages – RunPTO:** We will be moving forward with the RunPTO program. This will contain the digital directory, school calendar, and signup genius. We will use the signup genius for the Panther Prowl still. Andrea will put together screen shots as a tutorial for sign up for RunPTO to help families navigate the program.
  
- **KingFish Game – June Follow up:** The game went well, we had a good turn out. Nikki stated that she will be willing to run this event again this year but would like someone to shadow her, as Owen will be graduating. While speaking of the Kenosha Kingfish, a program that they offer was brought up that we may want to research and participate in. They have a reading program called the Little Fish Reading Party where kids can earn free game tickets. It was also mentioned that Kwik Trip has a reading program as well called Kwik Books.
- **Kindergarten Mixer Follow Up:** The event day went smoothly. There was a small hiccup with the water bottles so we may want to review those and reassess what ones to use next year. Due to this hiccup the amount spent turned out to be a little more than anticipated. A total of \$644.62 was spent. This new amount was approved by Gerou and Tritt.
- **Panther Bucks/ Paw Store:** There are still a lot of goodies left from last year that we can use. We will provide the same amount to restock as last year; \$5,000 for the year not including the Christmas Store. This motion was approved by Tritt and Greou
- **Ice Cream Social:** The event went well. Culvers provided 200 scoops and that was the right amount, there were some scoops left over but not a lot. The toppings provided were a hit! For next year we will want to put some signage out near the front door to make sure families are aware to come out for a treat.
  
- **3-5<sup>th</sup> Grade Bussing for Capitol/ Cave of the Mountains Trip:** Mrs. Rennock is requesting funding for the coach busses for this trip. She was quoted for \$2,650.00. A motion for this amount was approved by Kordecki and seconded by Greou.

- **Paris CHS Float:** The Central High School homecoming parade is Wednesday, September 24<sup>th</sup>. The theme is Once Upon an Homecoming. The trailers are covered. A budget of \$800 is being requested to cover decorations and candy. Motion approved by Wiechert and seconded by Burgess.
- **Teacher Wishlist:** Last year we approved \$175 for full time and \$100 for part time teachers. We will do the same this year with a total of \$3,450.00. (18 fulltime teachers/ 3 part time teachers) Motion approved by Gerou and Burgess
- **2025/26 Field Trip Allocations:** Last year we approved \$12 per student for the planned field trips. We will raise the amount this year to \$15.00 per student. We have 260 students to date totaling \$3,900.00. A motion for this amount was approved by Wiechert and seconded by Burgess.
- **July Golf Outing Recap:** The golf outing was a great time! We did not make as much as previous years but this was due to attendance being a little lower than the past two years. We did raise just over \$3,000 for this years event. We will contact Bristol Oaks to book next year's outing on 7/17/2026 and promote that date.
- **Panther Prowl & Prowl Assembly:** This year's Panther Prowl will take place on 10.18.2025. We are looking to update the sponge toss board this year as the old one is pretty worn down. Katey will work on the new board with an approved budget of \$300. Motion for this was approved by Burgess and Gerou. This year's funds will go towards updating the classrooms. There will be a Prowl meeting on 9.16.2025 for more planning information. This year's kick off assembly will be 9.19.2025 around 2:00 PM. This will be the 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Panther Prowl!!
- **Monthly Dinner:** No set dinners at this time. There will be a Paris Day at the Thompson Farm on 9.21.2025. Andrea will do some research and have the dinner ideas for the November PSO meeting.
